Adoption of the Agenda:

No changes having been suggested, Paul made a motion to accept the agenda, Allison seconded the motion and the council accepted the agenda.

Approval of the Minutes: There were no minutes reviewed.

Communications: None.

Public Comment: None.

Discussion/Action:

The Site Council welcomed new (Blanca, Blayke, and Sandra) and returning members. Allison agreed to be council president and Paul to continue in the role of secretary. All members were given binders to hold SSC materials for this and future meetings.

Roles and Responsibilities of School Site Council: Dr. Robertson reviewed the role of the SSC, noting that the council works with the principal on programs and budgets, the duties of SSC vary from state to state and even within states, and together the SSC and principal evaluate progress, make suggestions and primarily address topics that serve the students.

Discussion of LCAP Goals for Somis and how they connect to the state priority areas: Dr. Robertson provided some background on the Local Control and Accountability Plan and expounded a bit on the three goals for Somis (increase student achievement, parent engagement and participation, and student engagement in the school environment), showed where in the LCAP the detailed supporting activities and funding were broken out and encouraged all SSC members to read through the document for further discussion, review and updating at future SSC meetings (the master document is updated annually).

New California Dashboard. This topic (including a video and 5x5 grid) will be added to the agenda for the next SSC meeting.

CAASPP: Dr. Robertson noted that approximately 6 hours of standardized testing is conducted annually. Testing is done entirely online over a two week period. Grades 3-8 are tested in Language Arts and Math, grades 5+8 in Science, and results can be viewed in an online ‘dashboard’ (located at caaspp.cde.ca.gov).

Support of English Learners: We are reviewing CELDT data and CAASPP data.

Upcoming Events Calendar: Upcoming events were briefly reviewed, segueing from the Jog-A-Thon, Maria shared an anecdote about an OC district that raised over \$9M in one night.
